

## RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 2021-15Passed MARCH 3, 2021

SPONSOR: SAFETY COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL, OHIO BUREAU OF CRIMINAL IDENTIFICATION AND INVESTIGATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, various participating agencies, sheriffs' offices and the Ohio Attorney General, Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation wish to enter into a Northeast Regional Critical Incident Response Task Force – Memorandum of Understanding; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Chief of Police desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with such entities to enter into a task force to cooperatively investigate law enforcement officer-involved critical incidents and certain law enforcement use of force cases; and,

WHEREAS, it would benefit the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Mogadore to have this cooperative investigation services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor of the Village of Mogadore and/or Chief of Police are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Ohio Attorney General, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation and other local political subdivisions, in a form substantially similar to the one attached as Exhibit "A" hereto.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor, Clerk-Treasurer and Chief of Police are hereby authorized to sign and process all necessary paperwork to effectuate the entering of, execution and implementation of said agreement.

SECTION 3: That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described.

SECTION 4: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

SECTION 5: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 404 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.


