Resolution No. 2021-24

SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE CORONAVIRUS AID FISCAL RECOVERY FUND (“FUND”) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: This Council makes the following findings and Determinations:

- (a) The Ohio Revised Code allows the Village of Mogadore (“Village”) to establish special funds pursuant to R.C. 5705.09.
- (b) The Village desires to establish the Coronavirus Aid Fiscal Recovery (“Fund”) to set collect moneys from Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds.

SECTION 2: Establishment of the Fund. In accordance with R.C. 5705.09, the Village Council hereby directs the Clerk-Treasurer to establish the Fund.

SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 404 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety convenience, and welfare of the Village of Mogadore and the inhabitants thereof, to comply with the deadline, and provided that it receives the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


