Ordinance No. 2021-25Passed MAY 20, 2021

SPONSOR: SAFETY COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE UPDATED EMS FEE CHART REGARDING THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE'S EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore Codified Ordinances Section 35.03(A) states as follows:

(A)(1) Effective July 1, 2019, each person receiving emergency medical service from the village shall pay a utilization charge as determined in the Village's duly adopted EMS fee table.

(2) As long as the Village of Mogadore is a designated Medicare, Medicaid and/or Workers' Compensation provider, the village shall accept as total payment the rates and co-payments established for all individuals covered by these programs for the prevailing rate applicable to Mogadore, for both residents and non-residents.

(3) As long as the Village of Mogadore is a designated Medicare, Medicaid and/or Workers' Compensation provider, the village shall accept as total payment the rates and co-payments established for all individuals covered by these programs for the prevailing rate applicable to Mogadore, for both residents and non-residents.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest to keep fee table updated and in accordance with the rates published by Medicare, Medicaid and/or Workers' Compensation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: That the EMS fee table attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is adopted and shall be effective on June 1, 2021.

SECTION 2: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.


SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 404 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely update of rates consistent with federal and state publications, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.


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
