SPONSOR: STREETS COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL RESURFACING FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (AMATS) TO IMPROVE MOGADORE AND RANDOLPH ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for Resurfacing Funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) with an estimated cost of any of this project listed below and in acknowledgment of the AMATS “Funding Policy Guidelines”:

SECTION 2: That the Village of Mogadore acknowledges and understands the AMATS “Funding Policy Guidelines” and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application, on file with the Village Engineer, is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share is required to match federal funds.

SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 404 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.
