Ordinance No. 2021-29

Passed JULY 7, 2021

SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATES OF COMPENSATION FOR THE PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL AND COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE, OHIO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-33 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the salary for the President of the Village of Mogadore has not been amended since 2015; and,

WHEREAS, salaries for the members of the Village of Mogadore Council have not been amended since 2015; and,

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to increase the salaries of the President of the Village Council and members of Council on this incremental basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1: That effective on the date listed below, the annual salaries for the offices of President of Council and each Member of Council, which shall be paid monthly, shall be as follows:

<u>Position</u>	<u>Salary</u>	<u>Effective Date</u>
President of Council	\$7,200.00	01/01/2022
Council Member	\$6,000.00	01/01/2022

SECTION 2: That Ordinance No. 2015-33 be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 404 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of Village residents, the timely passage of this legislation within legal guidelines to provide for such compensation before the applicable, upcoming general election deadline, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
