

## RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 2021-35Passed JUNE 16, 2021

SPONSOR: SAFETY COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF MANUAL MONITOR/DEFIBRILLATORS AND OTHER RELATED MEDICAL SUPPLIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Village's potential ability for reimbursement under the American Recovery Act, the Mayor and Village Council have determined the need to purchase two (2) X Series Advanced Manual Monitor/Defibrillators and other related medical supplies; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council have determined that it is in the best financial interests of the Village to acquire the aforesaid equipment by purchase from Zoll Medical Corporation through a purchase agreement in an amount not to exceed \$66,778.88; and,

WHEREAS, the aforesaid equipment and the cost proposal from Zoll Medical Corporation were selected from a State Term Schedule maintained by the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services and will be purchased under the Cooperative Purchasing Program, which satisfies the requirements for competitive bidding under the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1: That this Council hereby authorizes and directs the purchase of two (2) X Series Advanced Manual Monitor/Defibrillators and other related medical supplies for the Village in an amount not to exceed the total acquisition cost of \$66,778.88, plus any financing and other costs as set forth in the Proposal.

SECTION 2: That this Council hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor, Clerk-Treasurer, and the Fire Chief to take such actions as shall be necessary to acquire the aforesaid equipment in accordance with the Proposal (or at a better rate) and this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: That the factual findings and statements set forth in the recitals above are hereby adopted and incorporated herein.

SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and HB 404 during the state-declared COVID-19 emergency.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the Village of Mogadore and the inhabitants thereof, and permits the Village to acquire the aforesaid equipment to timely complete necessary work and update equipment thereby maintaining and even improving service levels within the Village, and provided it receives the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, or otherwise take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
