

COUNCIL MEETING

MAY 20, 2021

Council met in session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Motion by Mr. C. Yoho, second by Mr. R. Schrock to appoint Ms. B. Van Dike President Pro-Temp for this Council Meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes.

Motion by Ms. B Van Dike, second by Mr. C. Yoho for the approval of the agenda as presented. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. C. Yoho, second by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt the minutes for the May 5, 2021, Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND ESTABLISHING THE CORONAVIRUS AID FISCAL RECOVERY FUND (“FUND”) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. C. Yoho seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2021-24; a second was made by Mr. C. Yoho.

Mayor Rick stated this is establish the fund for the money we will receive from federal government. We have not decided how this will be spent. Estimate of \$750,000 for the Recovery fund.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. Schrock presented Ordinance 2021-25 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE UPDATED EMS FEE CHART REGARDING THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE'S EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND DELCARING AN EMERGENCY.

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL RESURFACING FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (AMATS) TO IMPROVE MOGADORE AND RANDOLPH ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. C. Yoho made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. J. Tonsic seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. C. Yoho to adopt Resolution 2021-27; a second was made by Ms. K. Miller. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.




