

## COUNCIL MEETING

JUNE 16, 2021

Council met in session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Ms. B. Van Dike asked everyone to join her in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Council Meeting was held in Council Chambers. The meeting was opened to the public.

#### Second Reading-

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Ordinance 2021-28 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE, OHIO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2003-27, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Second Reading-

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Ordinance 2021-29 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATES OF COMPENSATION FOR THE PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL AND COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE, OHIO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-33 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NEW BUSINESS-

Mr. R. Schrock presented Resolution 2021-34 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

RESOLUTION AND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A CHANGE ORDER WITH BECK ELECTRIC COMPANY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. Schrock made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. C. Yoho seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Resolution 2021-34; a second was made by Mr. C. Yoho.

Village Engineer Matt Glass stated this change order is for an additional shut-off remote that is required by the building department. They came across it during their final inspection and it was recommended.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. Schrock presented Ordinance 2021-35 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF MANUAL MONITOR/DEFIBRILLATORS AND OTHER RELATED MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. Schrock made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. C. Yoho seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Ordinance 2021-35; a second was made by Ms. K. Miller. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. McDowall presented Resolution 2021-36 sponsored by Utilities Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING PROVISIONS OF THE OHIO SENATE OMNIBUS BUDGET AMENDMENT WHICH WOULD EFFECTIVELY PROHIBIT IN STATE OF OHIO THE NEW CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC-OWNED BROADBAND NETWORKS, AND THE ONGOING PROVISION OF BROADBAND SERVICES PROVIDED BY PUBLIC-OWNED NETWORKS SUCH AS FAIRLAWN GIG AND HUDSON'S VELOCITY BROADBAND, THEREBY HARMING THE ABILITY OF OHIO'S RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 21<sup>ST</sup>-CENTURY DIGITAL ECONOMY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. McDowall made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. R. Schrock seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. McDowall to adopt Resolution 2021-36; a second was made by Mr. R. Schrock.

Mayor Rick stated that the American Recovery Act Funds are allowed to be used for broadband.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from the Public: David Byers, 4029 Mogadore Road, inquired about a building permit for a shed next to his house. Village Engineer Matt Glass told Mr. Byers we will speak with him after the meeting and let him know what all is needed. Conner Byers, 4029 Mogadore Road, is an Eagle Scout and asked what he could do to help the community. Mayor Rick wrote down his contact information and will call him tomorrow. Jon Mencer, 242 S. Cleveland Avenue, stated how nice Lions Park looks.

COMMENTS from the Clerk-Treasurer: No comments.


COMMENTS from the Mayor: Mayor Rick informed Council an Executive Session is needed at the end of tonight's meeting to discuss personnel issues.
