

COUNCIL MEETING

JUNE 2, 2021

Council met in session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Council Meeting was held in Council Chambers and face masks were required. The meeting was opened to the public.

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Ordinance 2021-28 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE, OHIO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2003-27, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

First Reading-

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Ordinance 2021-29 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATES OF COMPENSATION FOR THE PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL AND COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE, OHIO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-33 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Ordinance 2021-30 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. C. Yoho seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Ordinance 2021-30; a second was made by Mr. C. Yoho.

Mayor Rick stated Clerk-Treasurer Scott Varney is looking into whether or not money from the Recovery Cares Act can be used to purchase.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Resolution 2021-31 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT/LEASE WITH NEONET REGARDING IT/TECHNOLOGY SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. C. Yoho seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2021-31; a second was made by Mr. C. Yoho. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. Schrock presented Resolution 2021-32 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO RETROACTIVELY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF AKRON REGARDING PROSECUTORIAL SERVICES RELATING TO CERTAIN CRIMINAL AND TRAFFIC CASES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. Schrock made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Ms. K. Miller seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Resolution 2021-32; a second was made by Ms. B. Van Dike. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. Schrock presented Resolution 2021-33 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE PART-TIME FIREFIGHTER AND EMT POSITION, ADOPTING THE AMENDED PART-TIME FIREFIGHTER HANDBOOK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. Schrock made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Ms. K. Miller seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Resolution 2021-33; a second was made by Ms. K. Miller.

Mayor Rick urged Council to keep the handbook and look through it.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from the Law Director: No comments.




COMMENTS from the Clerk-Treasurer: No comments.
