

COUNCIL MEETING

JULY 7, 2021

Council met in session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Ms. B. Van Dike asked everyone to join her in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Council Meeting was held in Council Chambers. The meeting was opened to the public.

McDowall, Village Engineer Matt Glass, and Law Director Marshal Pitchford were excused from the meeting.

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Ordinance 2021-28 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE, OHIO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2003-27, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Ordinance 2021-28, a second was made by Mr. R. Schrock. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Ordinance 2021-29 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATES OF COMPENSATION FOR THE PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL AND COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE, OHIO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-33 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Ordinance 2021-29, a second was made by Mr. R. Schrock. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS-

Mr. C. Yoho presented Resolution 2021-37 sponsored by Streets Committee as follows:

RESOLUTION AND ORDER ACCEPTING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR SUPPLYING LABOR AND MATERIALS NECESSARY FOR THE HERBERT STREET AND FENTON AVENUE INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. Schrock presented Ordinance 2021-38 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2021 CHEVROLET TAHOE 4WD AS A FIRE COMMAND VEHICLE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. Schrock made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. C. Yoho seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Ordinance 2021-38; a second was made by Ms. K. Miller. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. Schrock presented Resolution 2021-39 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION GRANTING RETROACTIVE PAY INCREASES TO CERTAIN PART-TIME EMPLOYEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. Schrock made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. C. Yoho seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. Schrock to adopt Resolution 2021-39; a second was made by Mr. C. Yoho. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from Council: Mr. Tonsic asked if the festival was going to take place this year. Mayor Rick announced there will be no festival this year.

COMMENTS from the Law Director: Kathryn Vadas gave the council an update on the ongoing process for a property clean-up located at 3764 Mogadore Road.


COMMENTS from the Village Engineer:
