

COUNCIL MEETING

August 18, 2021

Council met in session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Mr. C. Yoho asked everyone to join him in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Council Meeting was held in Council Chambers. The meeting was open to the public and face masks were required by all.

Present in Council Chambers was Mayor Rick, Assistant Clerk-Treasurer Rachel Osborne, Council Members: Mr. M. Raddish, Ms. B. Van Dike, Ms. K. Miller, Mr. C. Yoho, Mr. J. Tonsic, Mr. R. McDowall, Clerk-Treasurer Scott Varney, Village Engineer Matt Glass, and Law Director Marshal Pitchford. Councilman Mr. R. Schrock was excused from the meeting.

Motion by Mr. C. Yoho, second by Ms. K. Miller for the approval of the agenda as presented.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Ms. K. Miller, second by Mr. M. Raddish to adopt the minutes for the August 4, 2021, Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS-

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Resolution 2021-46 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION GRANTING RETROACTIVE PAY INCREASE TO CERTAIN PART-TIME EMPLOYEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. C. Yoho seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2021-46, a second was made by Mr. C. Yoho. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Ordinance 2021-47 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

ORDINANCE LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR VARIOUS SUMMIT COUNTY PROPERTIES, MOGADORE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. C. Yoho seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Ordinance 2021-47, a second was made by Mr. C. Yoho. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from the Public: Joe Henico, 3773 Argonne Street, asked if the trees being removed in the devil strip on Fenton Avenue was part of the infrastructure work? Mayor Rick responded yes and stated it is a part of the first phase of the Fenton Avenue and Herbert Street infrastructure project.

Jon Mencer, 242 S. Cleveland Avenue, stated he had a solicitor come to his house and asked how he would know if they were registered with the Village. Mayor Rick stated that all solicitors must be registered with the Village and if any resident is unsure or has concerns to call the municipal building or police department.

COMMENTS from Council: Mr. M. Raddish mentioned the experience he had with a solicitor a few years back.

COMMENTS from the Law Director: No comments.


