Resolution No. 2021-53Passed OCTOBER 6, 2021

SPONSOR: STREETS COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SELL A 1992 FORD F-150, A 2001 GMC SIERRA, A SPARE ENGINE, AND A LEAF VACUUM ON GOVDEALS.COM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village owns the personal property, i.e. a 1992 Ford F-150, a 2001 GMC Sierra, a spare engine, and a leaf vacuum, that it no longer needs and now desires to sell; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Village to sell the foregoing property as it is presently being under-utilized and counter-productive for the needs of the Village at this time; and,

WHEREAS, the Village has previously authorized the sale of such property by online auction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1: That it is in the best interests of the Village of Mogadore and its operations to sell unfit, obsolete, and/or unneeded personal property, which include a 1992 Ford F-150, a 2001 GMC Sierra, a spare engine, and a leaf vacuum.

SECTION 2: This identified personal property is hereby found to be unneeded.

SECTION 3: That the Mayor, Clerk-Treasurer, and/or the Mayor's designee are hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforesaid personal property in a reasonably commercial fashion, more specifically on GovDeals.com as previously authorized and contracted.

SECTION 4: That the internet auction shall satisfy the statutory minimum of ten (10) days (including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays) for bidding on the property.

SECTION 5: Advertising for the internet auction is hereby directed and shall be accomplished in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code and the Mogadore legislation on this topic.

SECTION 6: That the Mayor and/or his designee may set a minimum bid to be accepted for these specific items and any other terms and conditions for a particular sale beyond those as set forth in the Village's agreement with GovDeals, Inc. online auction company of the same which shall be provided on the internet at the time of the auction.

SECTION 7: That no proceeds from the internet sales shall be paid in cash, rather all proceeds shall be delivered to the Clerk-Treasurer by a cashier or bank check, or electronic transfer to the Village's general fund with verification of receipt delivered to the Clerk-Treasurer.
