A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2021-1 EXHIBIT "A" AND SECTION 2, PROVIDING PAY SCALE AND BENEFITS FOR VILLAGE FIRE OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the recommendation of the Mayor and the Finance/Audit Committee, the pay scale for Fire Department personnel shall be increased by 2.75%, and the pay scale for the Assistant Chief and Captain be amended.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the recommendation of the Mayor and the Finance/Audit Committee, the overnight pay scale for Fire Department personnel shall be eliminated and standard rates, as applicable to each member of the Fire Department shall apply.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That Exhibit "A" to Resolution 2021-1 be replaced in its entirety with Exhibit "A" hereto. The terms and conditions of the new wage and benefit package for the Village Fire Officers and Firefighters are set forth in their entirety in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, which is incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: That Section 2 of Resolution 2021-1 be amended to state as follows:

This Resolution shall be effective as of January 1, 2022.

SECTION 3: All other ordinances, resolutions, or parts of other ordinances and resolutions which may be in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby declared null and void and are of no further force and effect.

SECTION 4: The Village of Mogadore finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 5: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the proper protection of the Village against fire and other emergencies and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor or at the earliest period allowed by law.
