SPONSOR: STREETS COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF A PORTION OF PARCEL #55-00118 WITHIN DICK STREET FOR PUBLIC USE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the owner of Summit County Parcel #55-00118 on Dick Street has complied with the Codified Ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore's Engineer has reviewed and recommended formal acceptance by the Village of the improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Village hereby accepts the dedication of the right-of-way for a portion of Dick Street as shown in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the Village of Mogadore's home rule powers under Article XVIII, Section of the Ohio Constitution and is expressly intended to supersede any provisions of the Ohio Revised Code in conflict with its provisions.

SECTION 3: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Ordinance, were adopted in an open meeting or meetings of this Council that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitation, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely acceptance of the right-of-way, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
