A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF A GRANT FROM THE STATE OF OHIO BODY-WORN CAMERA GRANT PROGRAM FOR UP TO TWELVE NEW BODY CAMERAS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services Body-Worn Camera Grant Program has been created to award grant funds for body-cameras; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore, as part of the application process for these funds, has identified the need for twelve new body camera for its police department; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore has committed to fund its local share of costs associated with the cameras; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore is planning to purchase modern body cameras in the police department; and,

WHEREAS, the body cameras above-described are considered to be a priority need for the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Village Police Chief are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to apply for and accept financial assistance in the form of a grant from the State of Ohio Body-Worn Camera Grant Program to acquire up to twelve new body cameras for the Police Department. The Mayor and Police Chief are authorized to execute such documents as are necessary to apply for and accept the grant on behalf of the Village.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and Police Chief are hereby authorized to accept the grant funds as described above.

SECTION 3: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

SECTION 4: That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described.

SECTION 5: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely submission of the State of Ohio Body-Worn Camera Grant Program grant application within guidelines and requirements, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Police Department and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
