SPONSOR: PARKS COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE TO ENTER AN AGREEMENT WITH SUMMIT COUNTY TO ACCEPT THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE LIONS PARK PICKLEBALL COURTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore has identified the need for the reconstruction of the Lions Park pickleball courts; and,

WHEREAS, Summit County has awarded grant funds for improvements to the Lions Park pickleball courts; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore has committed to fund its local share of costs associated with the improvements; and,

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant Program provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore is planning to make capital improvements to the Lions Park pickleball courts; and,

WHEREAS, the improvements herein are considered to be a priority need for the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into any and all agreements as may be necessary and appropriate; including an agreement with the County of Summit, Ohio so that the Lions Park pickleball courts improvements can be made.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and/or Village Engineer are hereby authorized to accept and administer the grant funds as described herein.

SECTION 3: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

SECTION 4: That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the obligations incurred are hereby appropriated for the purposes described.

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SECTION 5: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely acceptance and administration of the Community Development Block Grant Program funds within guidelines and contractual and other requirements, to allow for the improvement efforts to begin when the weather will first allow, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Administration and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
