SPONSOR: STREETS COMMITTEE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2021 CHEVY SILVERADO 4500 MEDIUM-DUTY PICK-UP TRUCK FOR THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council have determined the need to purchase one (1) 2021 Chevy Silverado 4500 4WD Medium Duty Pick-Up Truck for the Service Department; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Council have determined that it is in the best financial interests of the Village to acquire the aforesaid vehicle and associated equipment by purchase from Ganley Chevrolet of Aurora, Ohio, in an amount not to exceed \$84,550.00 (amount to also include amount needed to up fit, equipment and mark the vehicle for use as a service vehicle), as set forth in the proposals, copies of which are attached hereto as Exhibit A (the "Proposal"); and,

WHEREAS, the aforesaid vehicle and the cost proposal were selected from a State-Bid Assist Platform.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1: This Council hereby authorizes the purchase of one (1) 2021 Chevy Silverado 4500 4WD Medium Duty Pick-Up Truck for the Service Department, in an amount not to exceed the total acquisition cost of \$84,550.00 (this amount includes money needed to up fit, equipment and mark the vehicle for use as a service department vehicle), plus other costs as set forth in the Proposal.

SECTION 2: This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor, the Mayor's designee for this purpose, and Clerk-Treasurer to take such actions, to enter agreement and sign all paperwork as shall be necessary to acquire the aforesaid equipment in accordance with the Proposal and this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: That the factual findings and statements set forth in the recitals above are hereby adopted and incorporated herein.

SECTION 4: The Village of Mogadore finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including R.C.121.22.


