

COUNCIL MEETING

July 6, 2022

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Mr. M. Raddish asked everyone to join him in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Council Meeting was held in Council Chambers. The meeting was open to the public and live-streamed on Facebook.

Present in Council Chambers was Mayor Rick, Council Clerk Rachel Osborne, Clerk-Treasurer Scott Varney, Law Director Marshal Pitchford, Village Engineer Matt Glass, Council Members: Mr. R. McDowall, Ms. B. Van Dike, Mr. M. Raddish, Mr. J. Tonsic, Mr. W. Bauer, and Ms. K. Miller. Councilman Mr. C. Yoho came in late to the meeting.

Mr. R. McDowall made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. J. Tonsic seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mayor Rick stated there was only one bid and the bidder did not attend the mandatory pre-bid meeting so we cannot accept it.

A motion was made by Mr. W. Bauer to adopt Resolution 2022-50 a second was made by Mr. J. Tonsic. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. R. McDowall presented Resolution 2022-51 sponsored by Parks Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CLERK-TREASURER AND/OR VILLAGE ENGINEER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR THE LIONS PARK PICKLE BALL COURT RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. McDowall made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. J. Tonsic seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. McDowall to adopt Resolution 2022-51 a second was made by Ms. K. Miller. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from the Public: Michelle Housely, 67 First Avenue, asked if the new fire truck was purchased with grant money. Housely also asked if there has been progress in hiring full-time employees for the fire department yet.

Scott Varney stated there was no grant money involved with the purchase.

Mayor Rick stated they cannot hire full-time people until after January, so no progress has been made with that.

Noris Hale, 204 South Cleveland Avenue, stated she reached out to Mr. McDowall weeks ago regarding five rebars next to the tennis court. Hale was concerned due to the safety of her children that were playing down there.

McDowall stated he only remembers seeing a text from Hale regarding the nets, not the rebars.

Mayor Rick told Hale the Village will look at and take care of those.

Hale then asked when will construction begin for the pickleball courts.

Mayor Rick stated start date will be around the last week of August or the first week of September.

COMMENTS from Council: Mr. J. Tonsic asked Mayor Rick for an update on the Testa Development Agreement.

Mayor Rick stated the agreement has not been signed and he is still negotiating with the developer.

COMMENTS from the Law Director: Marshal Pitchford provided an update on the legal process at 3764 Mogadore Road.


COMMENTS from the Clerk-Treasurer: No Comments.
