

COUNCIL MEETING

August 3, 2022

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with President Mr. M. Raddish presiding.

Ms. B. Van Dike asked everyone to join her in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all. Council Meeting was held in Council Chambers. The meeting was open to the public and live-streamed on Facebook.

Motion by Mr. R. McDowall, second by Mr. W. Bauer to appoint Ms. B. Van Dike as President Pro-Temp. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. R. McDowall, second by Ms. B. Van Dike for the approval of the agenda as presented. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. W. Bauer second by Ms. K. Miller to adopt the minutes for July 20, 2022, Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS-

Mr. R. McDowall presented Resolution 2022-**53** sponsored by Parks Committee as follows:

RESOLUTION AND ORDER AWARDING THE BID AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR THE LIONS PARK PICKLE BALL COURT RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. R. McDowall made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. W. Bauer seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. R. McDowall to adopt Resolution 2022-53 a second was made by Ms. K. Miller. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from the Public: Joe Henico, 3773 Argonne Street, asked if there would be sidewalks on both sides of Dick Street and if the chip and seal work was part of the infrastructure improvements.

Glass stated sidewalks will be on both north and south sides. Glass stated the chip and seal repairs were not part of the infrastructure improvements. The repairs were done to hold those streets over for the next four to five years while the Village applies for the OPWC grants.

Carl Housley, 67 First Avenue, thanked Mayor Rick for the information he requested at the previous Council Meeting.

Noris Hale, 204 S Cleveland Avenue, stated a typo in the legislation. Resolution 2022-53 should read enter a contract, not a contractor. Hale asked if said Resolution would be amended to correct the typo.

Law Director Pitchford stated the typo would be corrected to read a contract, not a contractor.

COMMENTS from Council: No Comments.

COMMENTS from the Law Director: Mr. Pitchford stated he and the Mayor met with the Mogadore Boosters regarding the baseball field project. The Boosters are still awaiting pricing, so they were not ready to discuss details yet. It comes down to what they can pay for both the infield and outfield. Pitchford will let the council know of any new updates at that time.

Mr. W. Bauer asked if there were any new updates on the Landenberger case.

Pitchford stated there was an inspection that accrued but no progress was made regarding cleaning up the property. Pitchford stated it was disappointing. We expect a hearing sometime in the next three weeks and hopefully, the court will deny the motion, and we will go from there.

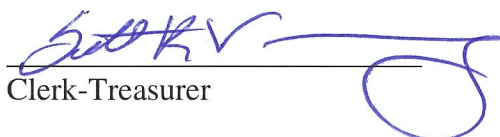
COMMENTS from the Clerk-Treasurer: No Comments.
