A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, FISCAL OFFICER, AND FIRE CHIEF TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER GRANT) (APPLICATION NO: EMW-2021-FF-00679); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security/FEMA under the Grant Programs Directorate's Fiscal year (FY) 2021 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) program has awarded a grant to the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Mogadore, as part of the application process for these funds, has identified the need for said funds.



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:


SECTION 1: The Mayor, the Village Clerk-Treasurer, and the Village Fire Chief are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to accept the financial assistance in the form of THE SAFER Grant from the Department of Homeland Security/FEMA on behalf of the Village of Mogadore.

SECTION 2: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

SECTION 3: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely acceptance of the submission of the grant award within guidelines and requirements, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Police Department and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
