

COUNCIL MEETING

October 5, 2022

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Mr. W. Bauer asked everyone to join him in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Council Meeting was held in Council Chambers. The meeting was open to the public and live-streamed on Facebook.

Others Present: Mayor Rick, Council Clerk Rachel Osborne, Clerk-Treasurer Scott Varney, Kathy Vadas, and Village Engineer Matt Glass.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Mr. C. Yoho for the approval of the agenda as presented.
Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt the minutes from the October 5, 2022, Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS FROM THE AUDIENCE ON PENDING LEGISLATION – Carl Housley, 67 First Avenue, asked why Ordinance 2022-62 reads the Fiscal Year 2021 and how can we spend the money now that it passed 2021.

Mayor Rick indicated it was applied for the grant in 2021 but it took the Federal Government that long to approve it. Mayor Rick indicated the Village can spend the money now with no problem.

NEW BUSINESS-

Mr. J. Tonsic presented Resolution 2022-58 sponsored by Streets Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION GIVING CONSENT AND AUTHORIZING THE RESURFACING OF A PORTION OF MOGADORE ROAD & RANDOLPH ROAD, IN CONNECTION WITH PID #115353; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. J. Tonsic made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Ms. K. Miller seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2022-58, a second was made by Mr. W. Bauer. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. J. Tonsic presented Ordinance 2022-59 sponsored by Streets Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN EASEMENT WITH AMERICAN TRANSMISSION SYSTEMS, INCORPORATED AND OHIO EDISON COMPANY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. J. Tonsic made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. W. Bauer seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Ordinance 2022-59, a second was made by Mr. W. Bauer.

Mayor Rick stated this if for Gilchrist Road right outside the Greenwood Cemetery.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. C. Yoho presented Ordinance 2022-60 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE CODIFIED ORDINANCES SECTION 135.06, TITLED "MENACING," TO ENHANCE THE CHARGES OF MENACING PUBLIC EMPLOYEES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. C. Yoho made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. J. Tonsic seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. C. Yoho to adopt Ordinance 2022-60, a second was made by Mr. W. Bauer. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. C. Yoho presented Ordinance 2022-61 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S FULL-TIME EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK AND CREATING FIVE (5) FULL-TIME FIREFIGHTER POSITIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. C. Yoho made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Ms. B. Van Dike seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. C. Yoho to adopt Ordinance 2022-61, a second was made by Ms. B. Van Dike

Mayor Rick thanked Scott Varney and Kathy Vadas for their help in getting the handbook completed to meet the guidelines.

Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. C. Yoho presented Resolution 2022-62 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, FISCAL OFFICER, AND FIRE CHIEF TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2021 STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER GRANT) (APPLICATION NO: EMW-2021-FF-00679); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. C. Yoho made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Ms. K. Miller seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. C. Yoho to adopt Resolution 2022-62, a second was made by Mr. R. McDowall. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Mr. C. Yoho presented Resolution 2022-63 sponsored by Safety Committee as follows:

A RESOLUTION DECLARING POLICE DEPARTMENT RADIOS UNNEEDED AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DONATE THEM TO THE MOGADORE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. C. Yoho made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. J. Tonsic seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. W. Bauer to adopt Resolution 2022-63, a second was made by Mr. C. Yoho. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from the Public: Carl Housley, 67 First Avenue, asked how much of the fire budget was carried over from last year.

Mayor Rick stated Scott Varney will look into it and get Housley the information.

Housley also asked how much the Fire Levy was supposed to generate.

Mayor Rick stated \$350,000.00 a year for five years.

Housley asked what will be done with the levy money now the SAFER grant has been received.

Mayor Rick stated the council recommends putting the money into a fund to use after the fire levy expires.

Dave Snyder, 382 Grant Avenue, expressed his concerns about a large trailer that is being parked across the street that makes it hard for neighbors to get by.

Mayor Rick indicated he would have a police officer let the owners know they will have to move it.

COMMENTS from Council: Mr. Tonsic thanked everyone for coming and sharing their concerns.

Mr. Raddish reminded everyone that the Historical Society will have its soup and sandwiches luncheon next Wednesday.

COMMENTS from the Law Director: Kathy Vadas updated the council on the legal process for the Landenberger property on Mogadore Road.


COMMENTS from the Village Engineer: Matt Glass provided an update on the OPWC application process for the Dick Street/Fenton Avenue project.


COMMENTS from the Clerk-Treasurer: No Comments.
