

COUNCIL MEETING

September 21, 2022

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Ms. K. Miller asked everyone to join her in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Council Meeting was held in Council Chambers. The meeting was open to the public and live streamed on Facebook.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish second by Mr. C. Yoho to adopt the minutes from the September 7, 2022, Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS-

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Resolution 2022-56 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY FISCAL OFFICE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Resolution 2022-57 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFERS WITHIN FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Mr. R. McDowall seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2022-57, a second was made by Mr. R. McDowall. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from the Public: Vicki Henico, 3773 Argonne Street, thanked Council for listening to her at the last council meeting and responded to the inquiries she made. Henico also commented on how well the parking situation is going at the School since the last time she spoke about it. Henico stated the parking permits seem to be working pretty well and it seems much safer.

Carl Housley, 67 First Avenue, asked for an update on the Landenberger property on Mogadore Road.

Mayor Rick stated there is a court hearing next Wednesday the 28th.

Housley also asked for an update on the Testa property.

Mayor Rick stated the TIF Development Agreement has been signed. Mayor Rick stated Joel Testa has till next August to start developing or the TIF Agreement will lapse.

Housley asked for clarification on the Facebook post made by Chief Cain regarding whether or not the new full-time hires will be paramedics.

Mayor Rick stated he would ask Chief Cain and get back to him.

Housley then asked how the Village decides if a radar control speed sign can be put on First Avenue.

Mayor Rick stated he would look into that and get back to him.

COMMENTS from Council: Mr. Raddish stated the Historical Society did a wonderful job putting together the Car Show that took place on Sunday, September 18th.


COMMENTS from the Law Director: No Comments.
