Resolution No. 2022-68

SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND ESTABLISHING THE FIRE FUND (“FUND”), AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED, by Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

WHEREAS, The Ohio Revised Code directs the Village of Mogadore (“VILLAGE”) to establish special funds pursuant to R.C. 5705.09; and

WHEREAS, The Village desires to establish the Fire Fund (“FUND”) to account for monies received from a property tax levy, and to allow such funds to be used for the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under Section 145.48 or 742.34 of the Revised Code, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, or for the payment of other related costs, and

WHEREAS, All monies collected as part shall be placed in a separate fund to be known as the Fire Fund (“FUND”) and is to be used only for the operation of the Fire Department.

SECTION 1: ESTABLISHMENT OF THE FIRE FUND. In accordance with R.C. 5705.09, the Village Council hereby directs the Fiscal Officer to establish the Fund, so as to allow for the accounting of money from the property tax levy for the purpose of supporting the Fire Department operations.

SECTION 2: STATEMENT OF EMERGENCY. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it will take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it will take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 4: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
