Resolution No. 2022-82

SPONSOR: STREETS COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDS FOR THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has set aside monies for Safe Routes to School Projects, (hereinafter "STRS Funds"), through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, applicants can apply for STRS Funds and be selected for funding by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and,

WHEREAS, the School Travel Plan, (hereinafter referred to as "the Project"), is an eligible activity eligible to receive federal transportation funding; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and execute on behalf of the Village of Mogadore an application and all related paperwork for SRTS funds for the Project to submit same to the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

SECTION 2: The total cost of the project is estimated to be \$20,000.00 of which the Village of Mogadore, if awarded the STRS funds, agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost over and above the maximum amount provided by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

SECTION 3: Upon completion of the described Project, the Village of Mogadore shall: Provide completed School Travel Plan with adequate community endorsements.

SECTION 4: If the application is approved for the funding, the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary to complete the Project.

SECTION 5: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
