Resolution No. 2022-84

SPONSOR: SAFETY COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE A NEW MEDICAL UNIT/AMBULANCE FOR USE BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT/EMS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Penn Care, Inc. is the owner of a new medical unit/ambulance, namely a Remounted Braun Liberty on the Ford E450 4x2; and,

WHEREAS, the vehicle is needed for use by the Fire Department/EMS and emergency medical purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the aforesaid vehicle and the cost proposal were selected from a State Term Schedule maintained by the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services and will be purchased under the Cooperative Purchasing Program, which satisfies the requirements for competitive bidding under the Ohio Revised Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Village has established guidelines for the purchase of vehicles, and those requirements are met herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized, on behalf of the Village of Mogadore, to enter into an agreement with Penn Care, Inc. for the purchase of the subject vehicle, being a REMOUNTED Braun Liberty on the Ford E450 4x2 in an amount up to \$260,000.00.

SECTION 2: That it is in the best interest of the Village to purchase the subject vehicle.

SECTION 3: The fair market value of the vehicle that is the subject of this Resolution is approximately \$244,862.00.

SECTION 4: That the recitals set forth above are incorporated by reference herein.

SECTION 5: The Mayor, Clerk-Treasurer, and Village Fire Chief are each authorized and directed to sign and/or enter into any instruments of conveyance or other documents necessary to carry forth the provisions of this Resolution once the Purchase Agreement has been signed.

SECTION 6: That, to the extent not already done so, the funds required for the payment of the subject obligations incurred hereby are appropriated for the purposes described.

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SECTION 7: That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 8: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of Village residents, to allow for the timely submission and execution of the approved Agreement within guidelines and time requirements, and to allow for the continued operations of the Village Fire Department and other departments and shall, therefore, take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
