AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2022-1, SECTION 1, REGARDING THE WAGES FOR PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS IN THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 3.10 of the Charter provides Council with the authority to create positions, duties, compensation, and fix qualifications for Village employees; and,

WHEREAS, Council has previously deemed it necessary and advisable to create part-time police officer positions within the Village of Mogadore Police Department; and,

WHEREAS, The Chief of the Mogadore Police Department has requested an increase in the hourly wages paid to part-time police officers; and,

WHEREAS, Council has determined that these changes are necessary to maintain adequate staffing of part-time police officers and to continue to attract qualified applicants when a part-time vacancy exists in the police department; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: Effective January 1, 2023, the part-time police officer positions shall be compensated at the starting hourly rate of \$16.96 per hour until successful completion of the training period with the department. Upon successful completion of the training, compensation will then be increased to \$19.62 per hour. In addition, part-time police officers will receive a clothing and equipment allowance of \$500.00 annually.

SECTION 2: Council declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure immediately and necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Mogadore, and for reasons that concern the efficient operation of the Village Police Department, provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
