COUNCIL MEETING

December 21, 2022

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Mr. M. Raddish asked everyone to join him in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Council Meeting was held in Council Chambers. The meeting was open to the public and live-streamed on Facebook.

<u>COMMENTS FROM THE AUDIENCE ON PENDING LEGISLATION</u> – Carl Housley, 67 First Avenue, inquired about employee pay raises referenced to 2022-87. Housley looked at past legislation and wondered why the Firemen were getting more than one raise a year in the past several years.

Mayor Rick indicated all the Village's employees get a pay raise once every year and the Firefighters are no different. There have been no special raises for the Fire Department.
