

## COUNCIL MEETING

January 18, 2023

Council met in regular session at 5:30 p.m. with Mayor Rick presiding.

Mr. W. Bauer asked everyone to join him in a moment of reflection for their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Council Meeting was held in Council Chambers. The meeting was open to the public and live-streamed on Facebook.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Ms. K. Miller for the approval of the agenda as presented.

Motion by Mr. M. Raddish, second by Mr. R. McDowall to adopt the minutes from January 4, 2023, Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS FROM THE AUDIENCE ON PENDING LEGISLATION – Carl Housley, 67 First Avenue, commented on Resolution 2023-11 “Wages and Benefit Package for Full-Time Employees other than the Police Officers”. Housley stated he would like to see them by title to reflect what group they are in, an example being full-time Firemen, Service Department, and Clerk-Treasurer. Housley stated if you had to go back through legislation it would make it easier to find.

Ms. B. Van Dike presented Resolution 2023-11 sponsored by Finance Committee as follows:

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2022-93, INCLUDING EXHIBIT A THERETO, ENTITLED "WAGE AND BENEFIT PACKAGE FOR FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES OTHER THAN POLICE OFFICERS," TO REVISE THE VACATION BENEFITS PROVIDED TO SUCH EMPLOYEES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

Ms. B. Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; Ms. K. Miller seconded the motion. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ms. B. Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2023-11, a second was made by Mr. R. McDowall.

Mayor Rick stated the only change to this Resolution is the vacation. Mayor Rick stated there are several other issues on here he would like to address at the next work session, one being what Housley mentioned, and the clothing allowance.

COMMENTS from the Public: Jon Mencer 242 S Cleveland Avenue, stated as of January 1<sup>st</sup> it is legal to set off fireworks in the state of Ohio. Mencer stated other villages and cities have passed legislation making it illegal to do so and wanted to know if the council was doing this as well.

Mayor Rick stated the council passed legislation last summer making it illegal for residents to set off fireworks within the Village.




