A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF GARY W. MAAG AS ROAD SUPERVISOR FOR THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, due to a vacancy in the position of Street Supervisor, the Mayor has appointed Gary W. Maag to the position of Street Supervisor, subject to the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members of this Council, to be effective upon such approval by Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to approve the appointment of Gary W. Maag to the position of Street Supervisor, effective upon the adoption of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The appointment by the Mayor of Gary W. Maag to the position of Street Supervisor is hereby approved, effective upon the adoption of this Resolution.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: Gary W. Maag shall be paid at the rate of \$31.59 per hour as the Street Supervisor until such time as this Council revises such rate of pay.

SECTION 3: This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the purpose of immediately approving the appointment of Gary W. Maag to the position of Street Supervisor so that the Street Department may continue orderly operations, and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
