Resolution No. 2023-61

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND ESTABLISHING THE K-9 DONATION FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 5705.09 of the Ohio Revised Code directs the Village to establish special funds pursuant to R.C. 5705.09 for each class of revenue other than the general property tax that is used for a particular purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to establish the K-9 Donation Fund to account for monies received from donations, and to allow such funds to be used only to support the Village's Law Enforcement Canine (K-9) Program; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to establish the K-9 Donation Fund to account for monies received from donations, and to allow such funds to be used only to support the Village's Law Enforcement Canine (K-9) Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: In accordance with Section 5705.09 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council hereby authorizes and directs the Clerk-Treasurer to establish the K-9 Donation Fund to account for monies received from donations, and to allow such funds to be used only to support the Village's Law Enforcement Canine (K-9) Program.

SECTION 2: This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the purpose of immediately create the aforementioned fund to immediately begin receiving donations for the Village's Law Enforcement Canine (K-9) Program, and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
