Resolution No. 2023-108

SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 1 OF RESOLUTION NO. 2023-5 TO INCREASE THE COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR'S COURT MAGISTRATE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 33.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village provides this Council with the authority to establish and determine the compensation of the Magistrate of the Mayor's Court; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended increasing the compensation of the Magistrate of the Mayor's Court; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to increase the compensation of the Magistrate of the Mayor's Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That as to compensation, Resolution No. 2023-5, Section 1 is hereby amended to state as follows:

"...The compensation for the services of the Mayor's Court Magistrate shall be an annual salary of \$8,000.00 and such amount shall be paid by the Village."

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be effective as of December 30, 2023.

SECTION 3: The Village of Mogadore finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the purpose of immediately establishing the pay for Magistrate for January 1, 2024, and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


