Ordinance No. 2024-69

SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION OF SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES, CERTIFYING THEM TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Budget Commission of Summit County, Ohio has certified its action thereon to this Council together with an estimate by the County Fiscal Officer of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council in fiscal year 2025, and what part thereof is without, and what part is within the ten-mill tax limitation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5705.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to accept the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission of Summit County, authorize the necessary tax levies and to certify the same to the Summit County Fiscal Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The amounts and rates to be levied upon the tax duplicate of the Village in fiscal year 2025, as determined by the Budget Commission of Summit County, Ohio in its certification, be and the same are hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: This Council hereby authorizes the amounts and rates of each tax necessary to be levied upon the tax duplicate of the Village within and without the ten-mill limitation as follows:

<u>Police Pension</u> Summit and Portage County	\$35,251	0.30
<u>Fire & EMS</u> Summit and Portage County	\$347,195	3.50
Total	\$599,825	5.65

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SECTION 3: The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Summit County Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 4: This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 5: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the purpose of immediately taking the actions set forth herein in a timely manner to ensure that the same be completed and the rates and amounts of the levies be certified to the Summit County Fiscal Officer as soon as possible, and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
