A RESOLUTION REVISING THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR GREENWOOD CEMETERY, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2025, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village operates Greenwood Cemetery within the Village boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended that the fee schedule for Greenwood Cemetery be revised, effective January 1, 2025, as a result of increased costs to operate the same; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to revise the fee schedule for Greenwood Cemetery, effective January 1, 2025, as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: Effective January 1, 2025, the fee schedule for Greenwood Cemetery shall be as follows:

Purchase of Full Grave Lot

Residents \$ 250.00 Non-residents \$1,200.00

<u>Full Grave Lot Open and Closing Costs – Full Burial</u>

Residents \$ 300.00 Non-residents \$ 600.00

Full Grave Lot Open and Closing Costs – Cremains Burial

Residents \$ 125.00 Non-residents \$ 165.00

Cremains Garden Lots, Stone, Open and Closing Costs

Residents \$1,100.00 Non-residents \$1,650.00

Additional charge to complete engraving on stone upon

service determined by the monument company.

Weekend and Holiday Burials

Additional \$ 250.00

All foundation costs, including Military Marker Foundations, will be determined by Executive Order of the Mayor and will be based on actual market cost.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the purpose of immediately revising the fee schedule so that the Village may recover its full costs due to price increase as soon as possible, and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
