Resolution No. 2025-36

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A FEDERAL CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY TO IMPROVE THE STATE ROUTE 532 AND MOGADORE ROAD INTERSECTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has set aside monies for Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ) projects through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation (ODOT), which is administered by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS); and

WHEREAS, Local Public Agencies (LPAs) may apply for these monies and be selected for funding by the Ohio Association of Regional Councils (OARC), who has been charged with management of the statewide CMAQ program by ODOT; and

WHEREAS, the Village anticipates the need to improve the intersection of State Route 532 and Mogadore Road in the Village's Central Business District, including minor widening on all intersection corners and the addition of eastbound and southbound right-only turn lanes, and signal and sidewalk improvements (the "Improvements"), which is a transportation improvement activity eligible to receive federal CMAQ funding; and

WHEREAS, if requested CMAQ funds are granted, the Village shall be responsible for at least 20 percent of the eligible costs of the Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the completion of the Improvements are in important to the Village's attempts to improve safety and reduce congestion, which is vital to improving the quality of life for the residents of the Village and motoring public by reducing emissions, and improving their overall safety and well-being; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village of Mogadore to authorize the Mayor to apply for and accept CMAQ funds for the Improvements, as provided for herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for Federal Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality (CMAQ) Funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) for the following Improvements:

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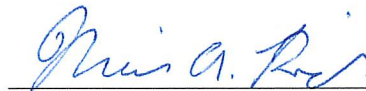
- (1) Along State Route 532 and Mogadore Road, improvements along each intersection approach of approximately 400 feet, including new eastbound and southbound right-turn-only lanes, wider corner curb radii on all four corners, sidewalk improvements to accommodate widening and promote improved connectivity, and signal improvements. This project is estimated to have a cost of \$2,319,285.

SECTION 2: The Village acknowledges and understands the Federal Highway Administration 2024 CMAQ Guidance and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share of at least 20% CMAQ funds.

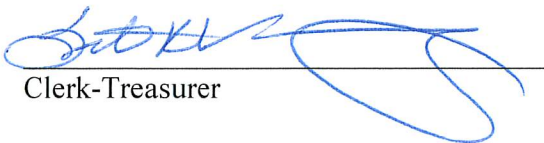
SECTION 3: This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the purpose of applying for funding in the next 30 days, and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
