A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES FOR THE VILLAGE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit ("County") has provided the Village with an Intergovernmental Agreement for the provision of animal control services within the Village for a term beginning retroactively on September 1, 2025 through August 31, 2030, at the rates set forth in the attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to authorize the Mayor to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement with the County for animal control services for a term beginning retroactively on September 1, 2025 through August 31, 2030, at the rates provided in the attached Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Intergovernmental Agreement with the County of Summit to provide animal control services to the Village for a term beginning retroactively on September 1, 2025 through August 31, 2030, at the rates set forth in the Intergovernmental Agreement, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the purpose of immediately ensuring that animal control services are continued on an ongoing basis due to the expiration of the prior agreement with the County, and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
