A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE SUMMIT COUNTY COMBINED GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT FOR SERVICES RELATED TO THE NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2026 TO DECEMBER 31, 2030, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Summit County Combined General Health District ("Health District") currently assists the Village with certain services ("Services") pertaining to Minimum Control Measure #3 of the general National Pollutant Control Discharge Elimination System Permit ("NPDES Permit"); and

WHEREAS, the Health District has proposed that it enter into a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") with the Village to continue providing the Services for the NPDES Permit for the period of January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2030, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to authorize the Mayor to execute the MOU for the Health District to continue to provide the Services for the NPDES Permit for the period of January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2030.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the MOU for the Health District to continue to provide the Services for the NPDES Permit for the period of January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2030, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2: This Council funds and determines all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the purpose of immediately authorizing the execution of the MOU prior to the commencement of the term thereof, and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
