A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE RE-APPOINTMENT OF LINDA SANSON TO THE VILLAGE CEMETERY BOARD FOR A TERM OF JANUARY 1, 2026 TO DECEMBER 31, 2028, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11.01 of the Village's Charter, the Village Cemetery Board shall consist of members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed with the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members of this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended the re-appointment of Linda Sansom as a member of the Village Cemetery Board for a three-year term effective January 1, 2026, and continuing until December 31, 2028; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to confirm the re-appointment of Linda Sansom as a member of the Village Cemetery Board for a three-year term effective January 1, 2026 and continuing until December 31, 2028.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Portage and Summit, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The re-appointment of Linda Sansom as a member of the Village Cemetery Board effective for a three-year term commencing January 1, 2026 and continuing until December 31, 2028 is hereby confirmed.

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed virtual, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the purpose of immediately authorizing the re-appointment of the aforementioned position given the expiration of the prior term, and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


