A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF EDDIE WHITT TO THE VILLAGE'S BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS FOR A TERM COMMENCING ON JANUARY 1, 2026 AND ENDING ON DECEMBER 31, 2028, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10.01 of the Village's Charter, six of the seven members of the Village's Board of Zoning Appeals shall be electors of the Village not serving on this Council appointed by the Mayor with approval by the Council to three year terms; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Eddie Whitt to serve as a member of the Village's Board of Zoning Appeals for a term commencing on January 1, 2026 and ending on December 31, 2028; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to confirm the appointment of Eddie Whitt to the Village's Board of Zoning Appeals for a term commencing on January 1, 2026 and ending on December 31, 2028.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: This Council hereby confirms the appointment of appointments of Eddie Whitt to the Village's Board of Zoning Appeals for a term commencing on January 1, 2026 and ending on December 31, 2028.

SECTION 2: The Village of Mogadore finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the purpose of immediately confirming the aforementioned appointment given the expiration of the prior term, and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
