Wednesday March 18, 2026

The council met in regular session at 5:30 pm with Mayor Rick presiding.

The Council Meeting was held in the Council Chambers. The meeting was open to the public and was posted to the Village's Facebook page after the meeting was held.

Roll Call: Yoho, McDowall, Van Dike, Raddish, Bauer, and Miller were present. Tonsic was excused.

Others Present: Mayor Mike Rick, Council Clerk Jennifer Barnes, and Assistant Law Director Natalie Schulte.

Shawn DeWolf was sworn in as Lieutenant for the Mogadore Fire Department.

Motion by Van Dike, second by Bauer for the approval of the agenda as presented. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by McDowall, second by Van Dike, to adopt the minutes from the March 4, 2026 Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Van Dike presented Resolution **2026-22**, Sponsor: Mayor Rick:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE IN A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH CERTAIN OPIOD REGIONAL DISTRIBUTORS AND DISPENSERS, ASSOCIATED PHARMACIES, INC. (AND AMERICAN ASSOCIATED PHARMACIES); JM SMITH CORPORATION; LOUISIANA WHOLESALE DRUG COMPANY, INC; MORRIS AND DICKSON CO.; NORTH CAROLINA MUTUAL WHOLESALE DRUG COMPANY, INC.; AND UNITED NATURAL FOODS, INC. (INCLUDING ITS SUBSIDIARIES SUPERVALU AND ADVANTAGE LOGISTICS), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; seconded by McDowall. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Yoho had questions on compensation to the Village with this settlement. Natalie Schulte confirmed that there is compensation that is coming back over time.

A motion was made by Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2026-22; seconded by Bauer. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

COMMENTS from the Public:

Jon F. Mencer, 242 S Cleveland Ave, wanted to know how many Lieutenants we have on staff for the fire department.

Mayor Rick stated that Lieutenant DeWolf is the first and only.

COMMENTS from the Council: Bauer thanked the council for their Historical Society memberships.

COMMENTS from Mayor Rick: Mayor Rick stated that the owner of the old Dairy Queen is currently making improvements to the building in hopes of leasing it out soon.
