Wednesday May 6, 2026

The council met in regular session at 5:30 pm with Mayor Rick presiding.

Mr. Yoho asked everyone to join him in a moment of reflection of their own intentions. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited by all.

Motion by Van Dike, second by Raddish for the approval of the agenda as presented. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by McDowall, second by Miller, to adopt the minutes from the April 15, 2026 Council meeting. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Van Dike presented Resolution **2026-27**, Sponsor: Finance Committee:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STREET FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Van Dike made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; seconded by Bauer. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Van Dike to adopt Resolution 2026-27; seconded by Bauer. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Miller presented Ordinance **2026-28**, Sponsor: Planning & Zoning Committee:

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF 11.47 ACRES OF REAL PROPERTY FROM SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP TO THE VILLAGE OF MOGADORE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Miller made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; seconded by Tonsic.

Law Director Dodson indicated that he thought Ordinance 2026-28 could not be passed as an emergency measure. He asked council to just have a first reading of the Ordinance until he could verify.

Miller made a motion to withdraw the previous motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; seconded by Tonsic.

Miller presented Ordinance **2026-29**, Sponsor: Planning & Zoning Committee:

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING A ONE YEAR MORATORIUM ON THE RECEIPT, PROCESSING, ISSUANCE, AND APPROVAL OF ANY APPLICATION FOR A ZONING CERTIFICATE FOR NAICS 518-DATA PROCESSING, HOSTING AND RELATED SERVICES (DATA CENTERS) UNDER THE VILLAGE'S PLANNING AND ZONING CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Miller made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; seconded by McDowall. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Miller to adopt Resolution 2026-29; seconded by Van Dike. Vote. Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Yoho presented Ordinance **2026-30**, Sponsor: Safety Committee:
AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE VILLAGE CYBERSECURITY
POLICY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Yoho made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; seconded by Miller. Vote.
Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Yoho to adopt Resolution 2026-30; seconded by McDowall. Vote.
Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

Yoho presented Ordinance **2026-31**, Sponsor: Safety Committee:
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS AND ADOPTING NEW SECTIONS
OF CHAPTER 90 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES ENTITLED “ANIMALS”, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Yoho made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings; seconded by Tonsic. Vote.
Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Yoho to adopt Resolution 2026-31; seconded by Miller. Vote.
Unanimous ayes. Motion carried.
