Resolution No. 2026-48

SPONSOR: FINANCE COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REPAYMENT OF AN ADVANCE FROM THE INCIDENT COMMAND TRAILER GRANT FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village's Incident Command Trailer Grant Fund accounts for the receipts and disbursements related to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security grant awarded to the Village of Mogadore for the acquisition of an Incident Command Trailer; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the purchase of the Incident Command Trailer, the Village advanced \$84,750.00 from the General Fund to the Incident Command Trailer Grant Fund pending receipt of grant reimbursement proceeds; and

WHEREAS, the Incident Command Trailer has been purchased and the grant reimbursement has been received by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk-Treasurer has requested authorization to repay the advance from the Incident Command Trailer Grant Fund to the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, Council finds and determines that repayment of the advance is necessary to properly account for the transaction and accurately reflect the financial records of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Mogadore, Counties of Summit and Portage, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to repay and credit to the General Fund the full amount of the advance previously made to the Incident Command Trailer Grant Fund, in the amount of Eighty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$84,750.00).

SECTION 2: This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

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SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the residents of the Village of Mogadore and for the purpose of immediately ensuring the current and other financial obligations of the Village of Mogadore are timely met, and, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected or appointed to this Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
